

AD HOC COUNCIL ON WORK-LIFE ISSUES (COWLI)

July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024

Charge:

To provide guidance to the Provost and Executive Vice President in addressing the challenges of work-life issues as they relate to the recruitment and retention of employees and graduate students, with particular attention to how such issues affect diversity, equity, and inclusion.

Membership:

The Council on Work-Life Issues shall consist of the Chief Human Resources Officer or their representative; Executive Vice President (ex officio); the Provost or their representative (ex officio); three Arts & Sciences faculty (one from each division); one faculty from each of the professional schools (Tuck, Thayer, Geisel); three Dartmouth Staff; one Graduate or Professional students and one postdoctoral scholar. As an ad-hoc council, members will serve one-year terms, subject to renewal. The committee shall be co-chaired by a staff member and a faculty member, as appointed by the Provost.
