

COUNCIL ON GRADUATE STUDIES (CGS)

July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025

Functions:

- 1. To recommend to the Dean of the Guarini School, the Provost, and the Trustees principles and policies governing all aspects of graduate education.
- 2. To review and approve proposals for graduate degree programs (PhD., M.S., and M.A.) and to forward them, with recommendation, to the Provost's Academic Planning Council. Council jurisdiction does not normally extend to professional degree programs which are the exclusive responsibility of the faculties of the Professional Schools.
- 3. To certify to the Trustees that candidates have met all requirements for the granting of graduate degrees.
- 4. To submit a report to the General Faculty at the end of each academic year.

Membership:

The Council on Graduate Studies shall consist of the Dean of the Guarini School of Graduate and Advanced Studies, who will chair the council, the director (or designate) of each of the degree-granting graduate programs, one member from each of the Arts and Sciences (appointed by the Committee on Organization and Policy), Geisel, Thayer, and Tuck schools, and two graduate students.

The chair shall take the initiative in forming such special committees as are desirable for planning and coordinating interlocking interests of graduate programs with other activities of the various faculties, and with the responsibilities of existing committees of those faculties.
